### **ALL MENS CLUB MEMBERS**

Reminder from the first newsletter: There IS ONLY ONE DROP AREA on the entire course for the Men's Club and that is on #3 on the original front nine. Any other drop areas you see on the course are for other leagues.

Just a reminder to everyone to pay attention to your handwriting on the signup sheets and the score cards. If we can't read your name, you won't get credit for your score and maybe miss out on winning prizes. Remember, EVERY card should have your full name and local number from the handicap computer.

This week's rules is a specific Fox Hollow situation on the course. The stand of trees to the left side of the landing area on #5 on the original front nine is NOT a "red" hazard. At times in the past, this area has been marked with red stakes but that is NOT the case now. If you hit your ball in there and cannot find it, you must proceed under the rules governing a lost ball. If you find it in there but cannot play it, you must proceed under the rules governing an unplayable lie.

### **WED 9 PLAYERS**

There are still a large number of new players who don't have an established handicap yet. It takes 5 full 18-hole rounds to establish your handicap. For the first couple of individual events we have established a flight for these players. The Quota points event this coming Wednesday will be the last event where that flight will be used. After that, you will be playing at scratch until the handicap is established.

Wednesday, May 12 is the last day to sign up for the Match Play.

### **SATURDAY PLAYERS**

Next Saturday is the qualifying for the Classic. Sign up with your partner for a tee time and pay the extra \$20 entry fee per team in the Golf Shop. After qualifying, there may be a cut and the chairman will pair up the matches which start on June 5.

### **WED 18 PLAYERS**

If you signed up for the 4 Man Count 2 on May 12, call the Golf Shop to find your tee time. Keep in mind it was VERY difficult to give everyone their preferred time because so many people requested an early time.
